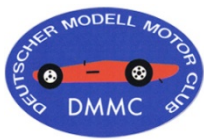




# 59<sup>th</sup> FEMA European Championship

## Invitation to the 59<sup>th</sup> FEMA European Championship for tether model cars held in Unterreichenbach-Kapfenhardt from 27<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2010

On behalf of the “Fédération Européenne du Modélisme Automobile” (FEMA) which delegated the organisation to the “Deutscher Modell Motor Club” (DMMC) “Renngemeinschaft Schwarzwald e.V.” (RGS) is pleased to invite you to the 59<sup>th</sup> FEMA European Championship for tether cars in Unterreichenbach-Kapfenhardt, Germany.

### Venue

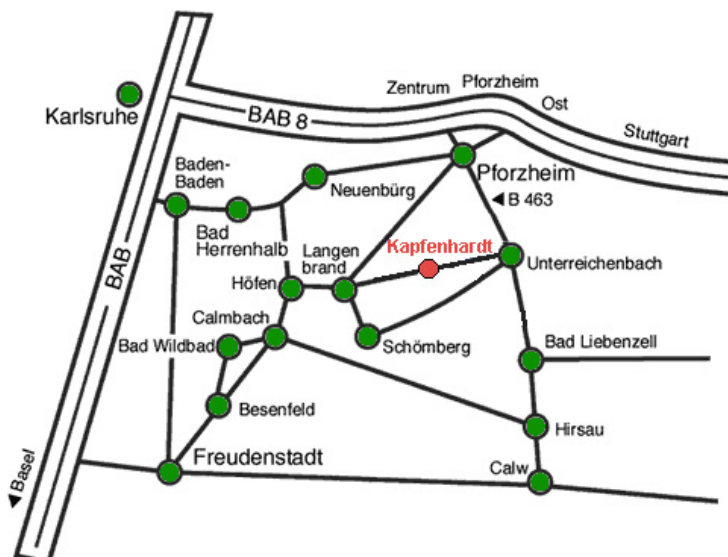
The track is located within the Kapfenhardt valley, approx. 30 miles west from Stuttgart and approx. 25 miles from Karlsruhe.

By car from the **north** via Autobahn A8 exit “Pforzheim West”, heading for “Calw” following road B463 to Unterreichenbach.

By car from the **south** via Autobahn A8 exit “Pforzheim Ost”, heading for “Calw” following road B463 to Unterreichenbach.

The route to the tether car track will be signposted from Unterreichenbach to the Kapfenhardt valley with signs reading “**Modellauto-Rennbahn**”

If you intend to go by plane you should use the airports Frankfurt (~100 mi), Stuttgart (~30 mi) or Baden-Baden (~40 mi) and rent a car at the airport.

## Starting order

The starting order for the first heat will be set in the official starting list. The order of the first three participants is set according to the 58th European Championship (2009), other participants follow according to the current FEMA world fastest ranking. For participants not ranked, starting positions will be drawn by the organisers.

The second heat will start in the same order as the first but from bottom to top. Third and final heat will be in reverse order following the ranking after the first two heats, except that the defending European Champion will start last.

## Awards

First, second and third place winners in each class will be awarded FEMA European Championship medals. The first five positions in each class will receive championship trophies.

The first three teams will be awarded championship trophies. The “Europacup” will also be awarded.
